- 5. Greasing of all pivot points on heavy equipment.
- 6. Any miscellaneous projects as directed by supervisor.

Reports directly to the job-site supervisor and the shop department manager.

**Typical Physical Demands**: Requires full range of body motion including handling and operating various hand and power tools, manual and finger dexterity and eye-hand coordination. Requires use of foot controlled pedals and sitting for extensive periods of time. Regularly requires standing and bending over for extensive periods of time. Requires reaching, crawling, climbing, grasping, kneeling, squatting and twisting. Often requires lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling items weighing up to 75 lbs. Sometimes requires working at heights. Also requires corrected vision and hearing within normal range. Requires working under stressful conditions.

**Typical Working Conditions**: Frequent exposure to rain, sleet, snow, dust, mud, heat, cold, noise, vibration and other conditions common to a construction site. Contractual obligations may require irregular hours, out of town work, overnight stays, nights, weekends and holidays.

**Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities**: Knowledge of Caterpillar equipment and dump truck preferred. Know all service points on all heavy equipment used by the company or the ability to be trained. Applicant must have sufficient proficiency in English to understand commands, safety rules, instruction sites and the ability to abide by them.
